

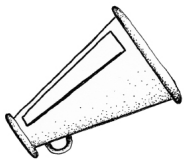
10 ways to help connect with the **FLORIDA WILDLIFE CORRIDOR**

Nature-based tourism is important to Florida's economy. Attend a birding festival or experience the Great Florida Birding Trail.



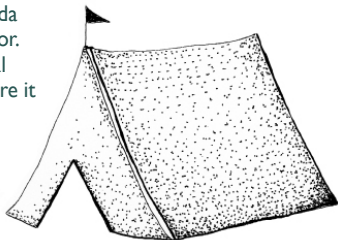
Teach someone to hunt or fish
