TOTAL CORRIDOR

18 million connected acres of wild and working lands

PERMANENTLY PROTECTED

10 million acres already protected, including public lands such as parks, preserves, and forest, and private conservation lands

OPPORTUNITY AREAS

8 million acres of mostly agricultural working lands which link the protected areas

URGENT & VULNERABLE

500,000 acres of ecologically valuable areas at-risk of development by 2030, where we must act quickly before they're lost

IRREPLACEABLE GAPS

Critical areas where no other options exist to connect the Corridor

COLLECTIVE ACTION

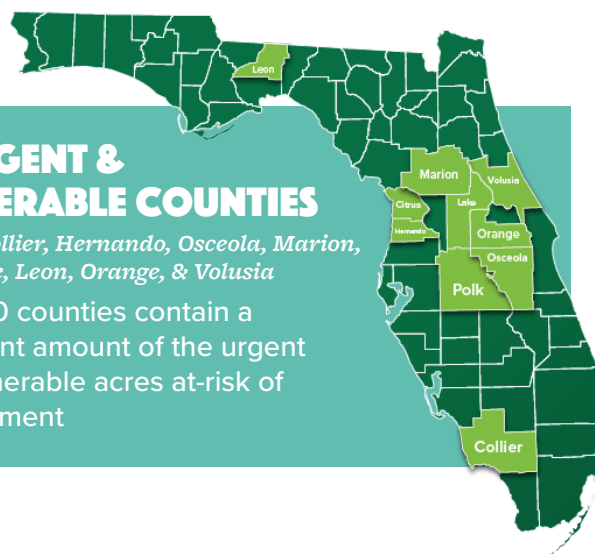
Collaborative conservation and restoration across hundreds of organizations to complete the Corridor

These 10 counties contain a significant amount of the urgent and vulnerable acres at-risk of development

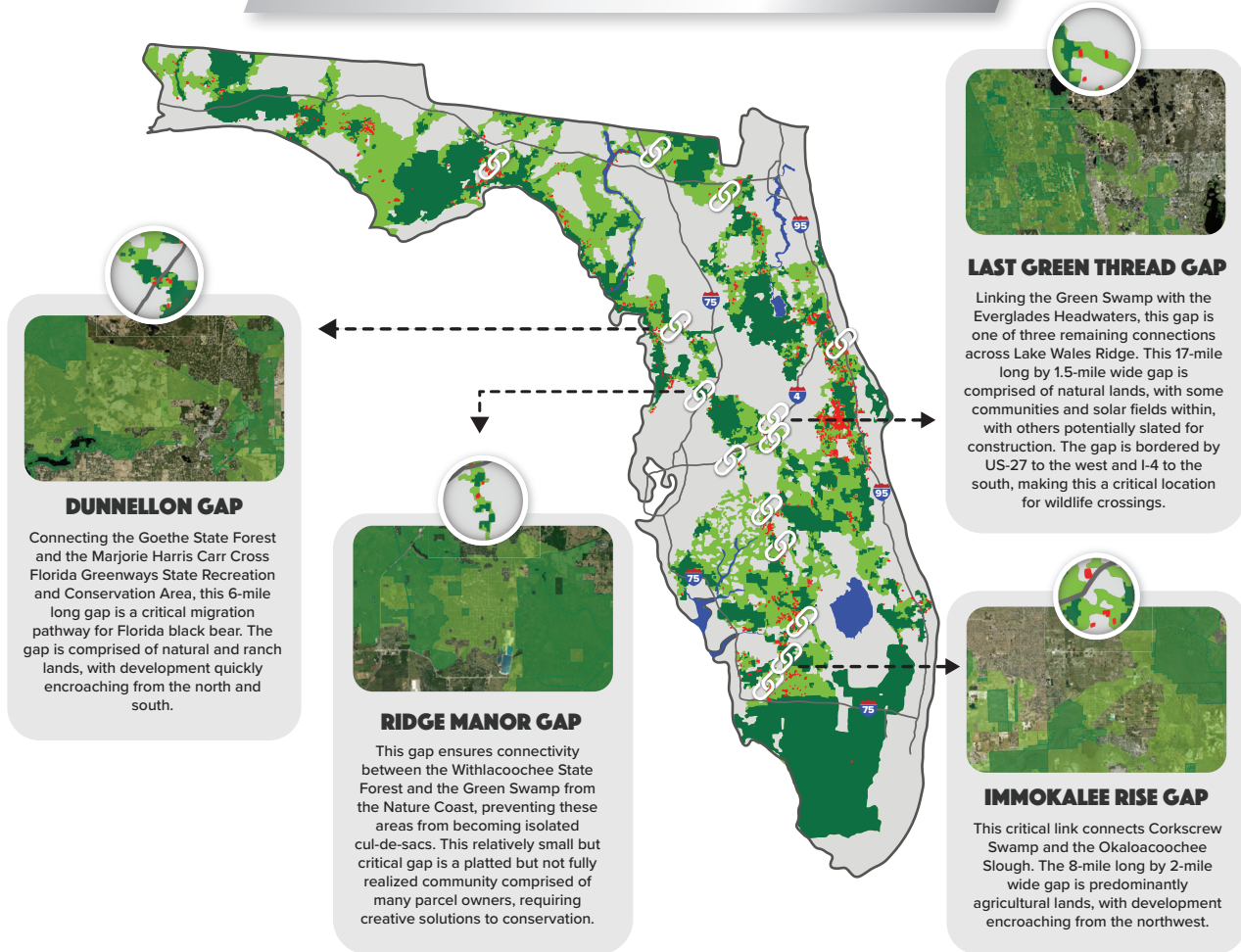

HOW WE MAKE AN IMPACT FOR THE CORRIDOR

PERMANENTLY PROTECTED

We promote connectivity and accessibility by celebrating public and private conserved lands and their benefits to wildlife and humans at least 4 times a year following Cabinet approvals for protection.

OPPORTUNITY AREAS

We advocate for at least \$500m per year to secure meaningful, consistent conservation funding at the local, state, and federal levels through policy and targeted outreach efforts.

URGENT & VULNERABLE

We address the urgency and vulnerability of the Corridor, mobilizing resources and new solutions to protect at least 54,000 acres a year through 6+ impact campaigns like expeditions, films, murals, and traveling exhibits.

IRREPLACEABLE GAPS

We keep the Corridor connected through our conservation work to bring tools and approaches to local communities with 4 Mind the Gaps workshops per year, investing 20%+ of the Critical Linkages Catalyst Fund, and by funding organizations that protect irreplaceable gaps.

COLLECTIVE ACTION

We serve as the Corridor's champion and guidepost, uniting action for its protection through our work such as the biennial Corridor Connect Summit, convening 4+ Corridor Collaboration Teams, engaging 500+ professionals on our online platform and leading the virtual Corridor Town Halls twice a year.
